Other times can be booked by members on sheets in the Club Room, or without booking if lawn available.

**Wed. & Thur. Mornings** are set aside for competitions running throughout the season, with accrued results. Anybody can play on any of the days, but there is a minimum number of games to be played to qualify for the trophy. There are 2 games on Wed and 3 on Thurs. Please attend at 9-45 to enter the draw for opponents. There is no fee to enter either competition, which can be joined at any stage in the season. Association handicaps are initially based on normal handicaps, but those for the golf remain as normal. (see back of card) When there is an odd number of potential players, the last to arrive will normally sit out the first game. Subsequent games are arranged by the initial draw.

### COACHING

Coaching sessions will be arranged throughout the season for players at all levels in both Golf and Association Croquet. These sessions will be advertised on the club notice board, and possibly by e-mail, giving members the opportunity to enrol on coaching courses they wish to attend.

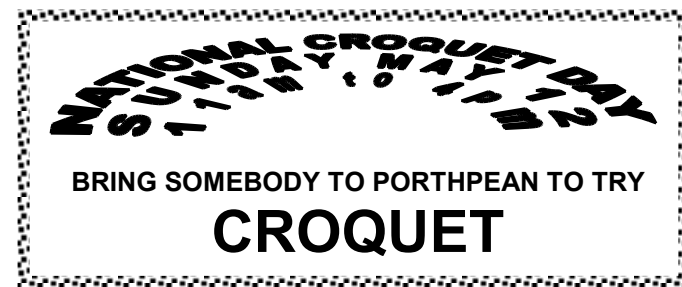

All are welcome to support the finalists, particularly on Sunday afternoon for the PRESIDENT'S-CUP FINALS.



**Handicaps** – Results of competitive singles matches, for both codes, must be maintained on the cards provided, so that handicaps vary automatically, but may also be changed, if deemed to be incorrect, by club handicappers, Automatic changes should be reported to a handicapper, who will up-date your card.

**Cards must be available for inspection when playing league or tournament matches.**

**Note** – For Short-Croquet rules, on Wednesdays, a different AC handicap applies, and must be recorded on a different card from the normal Association card.

All GC Thursday-morning competition results should be entered on a separate handicap card, whether played on full or half lawns, and count 10 index points. GC match results must be recorded on the new cards, using the trigger points below. Each handicap game counts plus or minus 10 index points.

**Note** – The trigger point between two handicap levels is **NOT** the same going up and going down

Eg – Golf Handicap 11 changes to 10 at Index 1200

Handicap 10 changes to 11 at Index 1150

Association handicaps are altered in a similar way.

The following is a precis of the CA ruling on automatic handicap changes becoming effective.

'Whenever a player's index is on or past a trigger point for a handicap change [see Tables] his handicap changes accordingly at the end of that day; except that all games within an event should be played off the same handicap; unless the event runs over more than four days, when it will be treated as separate events, and handicap changes between those events will take effect.'

For instance, achieve a trigger point: -

**(A)** During 1<sup>st</sup> day of a 2-day tournament: **the handicap changes at the end of the 2<sup>nd</sup> Day.**

**(B)** During any match of a season-long event, (eg Golf KO, Dowding Cup etc.) **or**

**(C)** A President's Cup Preliminary Match, **the handicap changes at the end of that day.**

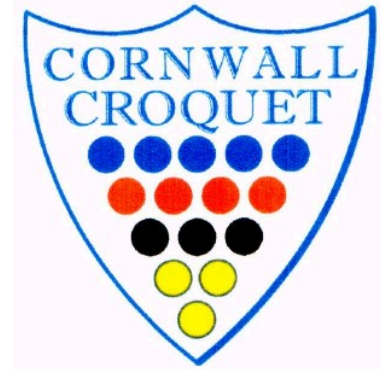
